Rules and Regulations

1. An Air Curtain Device (ACD) must be utilized at all times for the disposal of land clearing debris.
2. No burning may take place until the ACD has been installed, the site has been inspected and the permit has been approved by a Sni Valley Fire Official.
3. All open burning will take place after sunrise and be completed before sunset
4. Sni Valley F.P.D. must be contacted *EACH* day, before starting to burn after 7:00 am.
5. Applicants must call the Sni Valley F.P.D. at (816) 690-6990, (Option #2 in the phone menu) to determine burn status.
6. All fires ***must be*** supervised by the permitted, at all times, and until the fire is completely burned out and no smoldering materials exist.
7. Only vegetative waste originating from the above-mentioned location may be burned. A distance of not less than 200 yards (600 feet) from the nearest inhabited dwelling.
8. Criteria for approval of a burn day is: 1. Air Quality MUST BE "Green" 2. Winds MUST BE 10 MPH or lower. 3. Fire Danger MUST BE "Low".
9. The permission to burn in no way relieves you of your obligation to comply with other local, county, state or federal rules or regulations.
10. Permits are good for forty-five (45) days.
